Policies, Rules, and Regulations

Registration

• There is a non-refundable registration fee of \$50 for all students.

If a student temporarily withdraws (i.e., is absent from class for one month), their spot will be allocated to the next available student. Upon their return to dance class, a new registration fee will be required.

Families with siblings enrolled in dance classes receive a 10% discount on tuition.

Tuition Payment Information

Yearly tuition payments are accepted upon request.

Private dance lessons are offered at the following rates:

- \$35.00 for a half hour
- \$60.00 for a full hour

<u>Payment Details</u>

All customers must enroll in Auto Pay.

Auto Pay for tuition is processed on the 1st of each month.

Costume Fees and Recital Fees will also be included in the Auto Pay plan and will be charged on their respective due dates (please refer to the relevant sections for those dates).

If the card on file is not current, a \$15 late fee will be applied. You are welcome to pay all fees in advance. Please note that we do not accept checks or cash.

<u>Important Notice:</u> To drop or add a class after registration, please complete the Drop/Add form at the front desk. To discontinue automatic payments, you must submit a drop form at least 30 days in advance. No refunds will be issued if the card is processed prior to the receipt of the drop form.

If tuition reaches 2 months past due, that student will loose their place in class(es). The student will need to re-register and pay the registration fee of \$50.00. The monthly tuition is calculated based on annual rates and divided into monthly installments. Although some months may have more class times than others the payments will remain the same.

Rehearsals at the end of the year are also included in the pay schedule.

Recital

Our annual recital is set for June 20, 2026. More information about the event will be sent via email in January 2026.

Costume Fee:

The costume fee is \$95 per costume and must be paid by October 14, 2025.

Recital Fee For Dance Recital:

The recital fee is \$150 (\$100 for each additional sibling). This fee covers the following:

- A prop fee
- Digital download of the recital
 - Digital download of photos
 - Two recital tickets

The recital fee is to be paid in two installments:

- The first half (\$75) is due by February 12, 2026.
- The second half (\$75) is due by April 16, 2026.

(Note: This is separate from the costume fee, which is due in October.)

You are welcome to pay all fees before their respective due dates. Please visit the front desk to make your payment.

Tickets for the Dance Recital:

You will receive a code to redeem your two tickets included in your recital fee.

Tickets are sold separately at \$20 in advance and \$25 at the door. Please note that service fees apply. Tickets are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

If the musical theater class performs at a different venue, separate recital and ticket fees will apply. This class will present a musical production, with the date and venue still to be decided.

Attendance

- There are no credits or refunds for missed classes.
- Make-up classes must be arranged with the front desk.
- Due to preparations for the recital, make-up classes will no longer be offered after April 1, 2026.

Withdrawals

• We have a 30-day withdrawal policy. Please visit the front desk to complete a drop form.

Etiquette

- Proper dance attire must be worn at all times.
- Tights should be paired with dance shorts, and leotards are required—No midriffs. For further details, refer to the dress code.
- Students must maintain appropriate behavior in the classroom, including waiting areas. Disruptive students will be asked to wait in the lobby while their parent or guardian is contacted.
- No jewelry is allowed during dance class. Gum chewing is prohibited. Only water is permitted in the dance studios.

Miscellaneous

Do not leave valuables unattended. We are not held responsible for loss of personal property. Students must arrive to class on time and must be picked up promptly.

All students are to be picked up <u>inside</u> the studio.

Girls

Hair must be styled in a bun for ballet classes and pulled back for all other classes!

Ballet/Pointe:

 Pink tights, black leotard, pink canvas ballet shoes (leather shoes for ages 3-7) or pointe shoes. Ballet skirts are permitted, but pants and shorts are not allowed.

Jazz/Hip-Hop/Tap:

 Tan or pink tights, solid-colored leotard, and dance pants or shorts are acceptable over the tights. Wear tan jazz shoes (preferably the slip-on type), black hip-hop dance sneakers, and tan velcro buckle tap shoes for ages 3-7, tap dancers and Tan Oxford tap shoes for leveled tap classes.

• Lyrical:

o Black leotard, footless tights, no shoes.

Acrobatics:

o Any color leotard, footless tights, no shoes required.

For Combination Classes:

 Dancers should wear a solid-colored leotard, tan tights, and all shoes necessary for the dance style they are participating in (see above).

Musical Theater:

o Any color leotard, tights, dance pants, and tan jazz shoes.

<u>Boys</u>

• Boys should wear black dance pants, a white t-shirt, and the appropriate black dance shoes for their dance style.
